William Edwards Deming is celebrated as one of the most influential thinkers in quality management. His philosophy was clear – improving quality not only reduces costs but also boosts productivity and market share. His philosophy is one of cooperation and continual improvement; it avoids blame and redefines mistakes as opportunities for improvement. His key contributions include managing variability, the PDCA cycle, Fourteen Points for Management and a Seven-Point Action Plan - moving organisations from inspection-based to preventive, systemic approaches.
